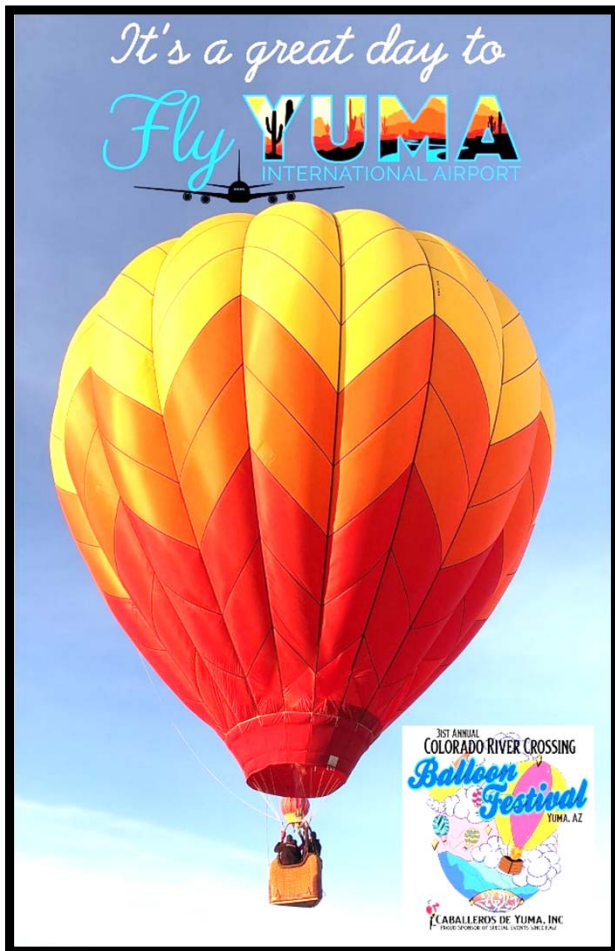

GA Apron Rehabilitation

Cemex Construction Materials South, LLC has completed construction near the Northwest Hangars along 32nd Street and the T-Shade areas. The contractor will complete work at the Self Service Ramp and Wash Rack at the end of December. The projects is expected to wrap up mid to late March 2022.



This project is part of the Airport's Capital Improvement Program (ACIP) and will improve approximately 98,000 square yards of paved aprons in an effort to preserve the pavement for the safety of the pilots on the civilian side of the airport.
