SUBJECT: General Aviation Apron Rehabilitation Update

As you know, in mid-August, the Yuma County Airport Authority (YCAA) began its General Aviation Apron Rehabilitation project which will ultimately improve or replace almost all paved surfaces used by out GA Customers.

The next phase of construction is referred to as "Task 2" and will include a complete reconstruction of the paved surface surrounding the Self-Serve and extending all the way to the Air Methods/Tri-State Careflight air ambulance facility ("Self-Serve Ramp"), as well as reconstruction a portion of the ramp on the South end of Hero Hangar Buildings A and B extending to the Wash Rack. **Task 2 is scheduled to begin on November 1, 2021.**

You are receiving this email because your aircraft storage hangar is located in Building A or on the East side of Building B. As previously addressed, YCAA staff and our Contractors have developed a phasing solution that removes the necessity of vacating all of the hangars, or not having access to the hangars, in the Hero Hangar facility during construction.

During "Task 2" tenants with hangars in Building A or on the East side of Building B will be required to approach and depart their hangar via the North end of Building B as indicated on the attached "Task 2 HH Aircraft Taxi Guidance". Please review this diagram carefully and do not hesitate to ask Million Air for assistance. If you need assistance in moving your aircraft, please give the Million Air team a call at 928-247-9571. Million Air's team of professionals will assist, without cost to you.

Our contractors estimate that Task 2 will be completed on or before December 15, 2021. This schedule is fluid and can shift depending on the weather, materials or additional work. We appreciate your understanding if/when schedule changes occur.

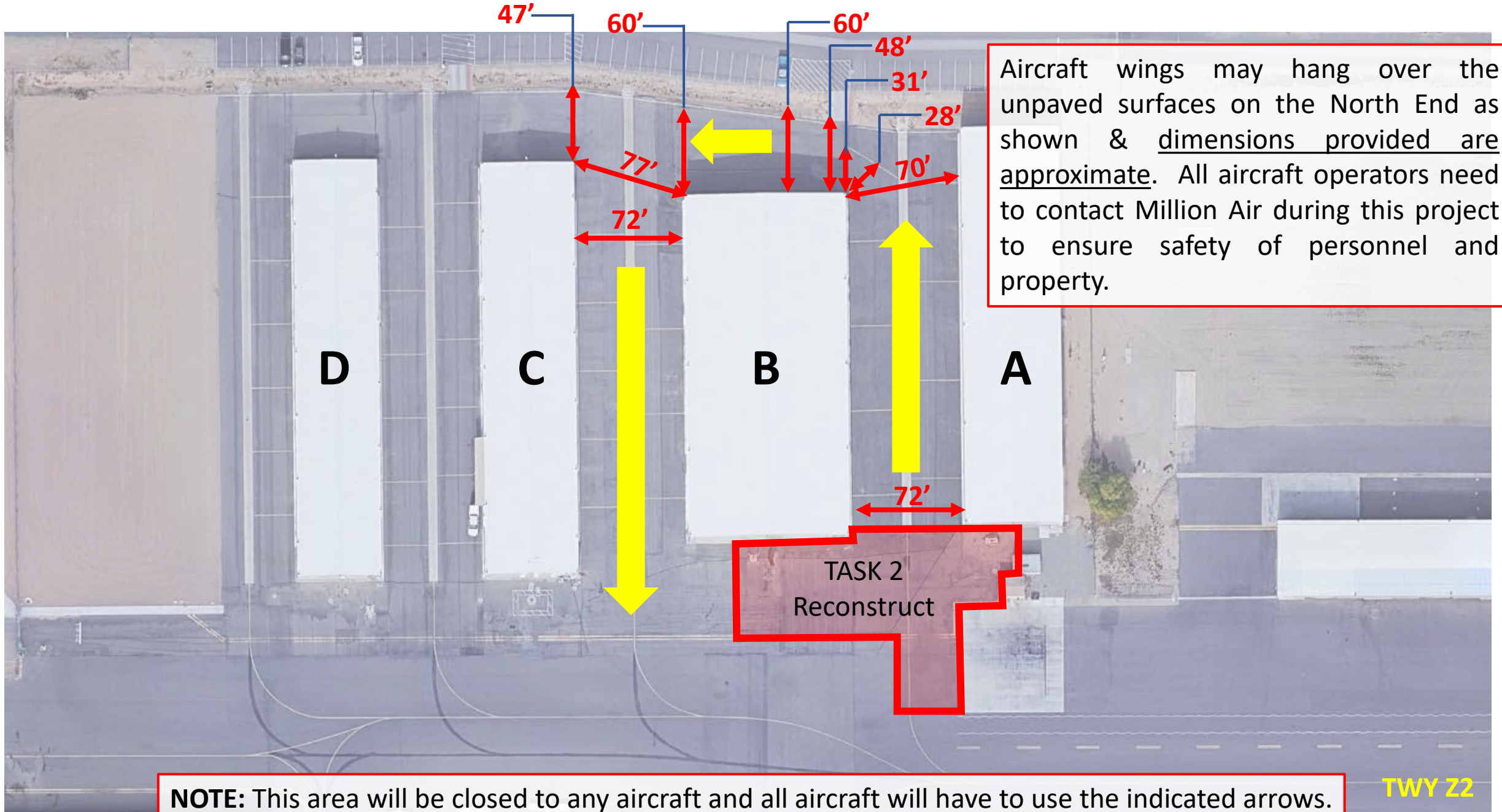
YCAA staff will contact you directly when the actual completion date is known.

Aircraft wings may hang over the unpaved surfaces on the North End as shown & dimensions provided are approximate. All aircraft operators need to contact Million Air during this project to ensure safety of personnel and property.
